UNIFORM

All children are expected to wear school uniform and the following items can be purchased from **My Clothing** (www.myclothing.com) or from **PMG Schoolwear** (www.pmgsschoolwear.co.uk). Links to these websites can be accessed through the school website. School Hoodies & Caps are ordered directly through the school and order forms are sent out on Parentmail at the beginning of each term.

Our children wear:

- ❖ Grey trousers, tailored shorts, skirts or pinafores
- ❖ Red polo shirts
- ❖ Red sweatshirts or cardigans
- ❖ Red/white checked summer dresses
- ❖ Red school hat (All children **must** have a school hat for the summer)
- ❖ Sensible school shoes, **not** open-toed sandals, boots, heels or trainers.

Our PE Kit is:

- ❖ Black shorts
- ❖ Red t-shirt
- ❖ Black plimsolls
- ❖ Black jogging bottoms (for outdoor PE)
- ❖ Red Hoodie (for outdoor PE)
- ❖ Trainers (for outdoor PE)
- ❖ Black football socks (for outdoor PE – years 3 and 4)



A pair of wellie boots are required to enable the use of the school grounds at all times. Please make sure that all items of uniform and kit are clearly named – please see school website for list of suppliers for labels. Lost property can be found in a box in the school foyer. The school does not accept responsibility for the loss or damage of clothes and belongings that are brought into school.

Second Hand uniform is available, please ask at the school office.

Hairstyles – All long hair to be tied back with a suitable band/scrunchies. Fashion bands are not acceptable. The school does not permit children to have ‘extreme’ haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children.

Jewellery – Children are not allowed to wear jewellery to school for safety reasons.

Plain stud earrings are permitted, but your child must be able to remove them for PE or medical tape should be provided to cover them up. If your child wears a necklace for religious/medical reasons, it must be inside their top at all times.

Please do not allow your child to wear watches which have large ‘toy covers’ or which play games/makes noises.

Toys and ‘treasures’ should not be brought into school.
