Communication & Language

As communicators we will listen attentively in a range of situations. Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations. We will also listen to and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion.

Physical Development

Fine motor skill activities involving baking, house construction, finger puppets, playdough cutters.

Gross motor skill activities will involve scooters in our outdoor area. PE Sessions will include Leap into Life & Best of Balls.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be playing cooperatively and taking turns with others. We will be describing ourselves in positive terms and talking about our abilities. We will be talking about how we and others show feelings of others.

Understanding the World

Comparing past and present through their own experiences and how they have changed from a baby.

Expressive Arts & Design

Exploring familiar traditional tales and introducing storyline and narrative into their play.

Literacy

As readers we will hear and say the initial sounds in words. We will enjoy an increasing range of books. As writers we will give meaning to marks that we make as we draw, write and paint. We will be writing our own name and other things such as labels and captions.

Maths

As mathematicians we will be ordering two or three items by height or length. We will be counting objects to 10 and beginning to count beyond 10. We will be selecting the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects. We will also be using mathematical names for 2D and 3D shapes.
