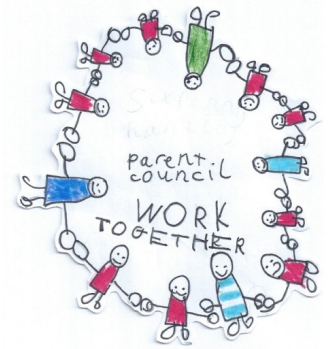


# Parent Council Newsletter
