


Parent Council Newsletter

Parent Questionnaire: Results

Just over half the parents responded to the questionnaire. In future these will be available at assemblies to try to raise the response level, as it is a factor assessed by Ofsted.

- Parents would like more information on reading levels and how the children's reading is assessed.
- It is planned to develop outdoor play through Forest School & by re-vamping our existing outdoor areas.
- Home Learning will be made as clear as possible and new strategies implemented to support parents and accommodate different ways of learning.
- Mid-term progress reports will be sent home for all years in future, not just at the end of Key Stages. This will be done prior to the parent/teacher consultations to give a clearer view on your child's progress.
