Parents have a legal entitlement for their reception age child to attend school on a full time basis from the beginning of the school year. A policy is available from the school office and all parents receive this as part of the induction pack.

The Link Group

The school runs a link group on the school site, in the summer term, which caters solely for children who are about to start school in September in the year in which they become five. If your child attends the Little Pennies Pre-School, on the school site, LA guidance states that "admission to a pre-school setting does not guarantee a place at the linked mainstream school".

Children transfer to Cranborne Middle School in the September following their ninth birthday and to the Upper School in Wimborne in the September following their thirteenth birthday.
