Home Learning

Home learning will be set every Thursday and due the following Wednesday. The tasks will coincide with our Theme, Maths and phonics learning in the classroom. In addition to this we do also have access to Times Table Rockstars (for Yr 2) and Spelling Frame; they are both wonderful resources that will help to develop your child's maths and spelling ability.

Creative Learning Journey (CLJ or Theme)

Our CLJ theme this term is called 'Cottages and Castles' and in particular, relates to our History, Geography and Art learning. We will be exploring the Victorians in History, maps of our local area in Geography and producing our own versions of Paul Klee's 'Castle and Sun' in Art.



In Science, we will also be investigating the properties of materials and conducting experiments in the classroom .

English

In our literacy lessons this term, we will be covering a range of reading and writing that will be delivered through the Read Write Inc. scheme. We will help the children to develop their phonics, reading comprehension writing composition and love for reading.
