Maths

Home Learning

Home learning will be set every Thursday and due the following Wednesday. The tasks will coincide with our Theme, Maths and phonics learning in the classroom. In addition to this we do also have access to Times Table Rockstars (for Yr 2) and Spelling Frame; they are both wonderful resources that will help to develop your child's maths and spelling ability.

Creative Learning Journey (CLJ)

Our CLJ theme this term is called 'Paws, Class and Whiskers' and in particular, relates to our Science, Geography and Art learning. We will be exploring and comparing different countries in Geography to the UK and looking at Edward Tingatinga as our artist in Art.

In Science, we will also be working scientifically around the topic of all things animals. We will be comparing features that we have as humans to that of other animals and identifying any similarities and differences. We will also be identifying a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and comparing them.

English

We have made great progress with our writing and continue to do so. We will be covering a range of writing objectives this term and continuing to writing creatively in addition to our Read Write Inc lessons.

Reading

We are still loving our reading in Voyagers and have noticed progress in all children's abilities and attitudes towards it.
